Pilgrimage Itinerary



Monday, May 7th Toronto – Toulouse

Departure from Toronto International Airport with connections and final over-night arrival in Toulouse. Inflight meals and entertainment

Tuesday, May 8th Lourdes (D)

Following our connection we arrive in Toulouse where we are met and transferred. Overnight hotel and dinner in Lourdes. After dinner we will join the candle light procession.

Wednesday, May 9th Lourdes (B, D)

Mass at the famous Grotto and time for the Baths. Our afternoon guided tour will include the Basilica of St. Pius X, the world's largest underground church, the home of Bernadette where she lived at the time of the apparitions, Lourdes Lake and other places of interest. Hotel overnight and dinner.

Thursday, May 10th
Lourdes / San Sebastian (B, D)

This morning is left free to join in prayers with others from around the world as you pray for the sick, drink water from the miraculous spring or submerge yourself in the healing waters. Attend the blessing of the sick and enjoy time for devotions. Departure by coach through the Pyrennees Mountains, view the spectacular Gave de Paul, the birthplace of St. Bernadette to whom the Lady appeared in 1858 near the Grotto of Massabielle Continue to San Sebastian - arrival, hotel check-in and dinner.

Friday, May 11th Santander (B, D)

Continuing to Loyola, with a stop to visit the birthplace of St. Ignatius founder of the Jesuits. Here we will see the 17th century Basilica dedicated to St. Ignatius. Behind the sanctuary is the family home. The most venerated place in the building is the room Ignatius, at the age of 30, was brought following a serious wounding at the battle of Pampiona. Hotel overnight and dinner.

Saturday, May 12th
Garabandal / Santander (B, D)

Departure to Garabandal. Visit the quaint village of San Sebastian de Garabandal and the local people, celebrating Mass at a local parish. Drive to Mount Limpas for a visit of Ignasia de Santissimo Christa de la Agonia in Limpas Santander. This village has remained unchanged since the apparition of Our Lady in the 1960's. Climb the small path of the way of the Cross which leads to the grove of nine apparitions situated on a bluff over-looking the village. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Sunday, May 13th Segovia (B, D)

Departure this morning to Segovia. Overnight and dinner

Monday, May 14th Salamanca (B, D)

Drive to Salamanca and Avila where we will visit the Cathedral with it's ancient alter piece, cloister, many chapels and works of art. We then continue our drive through the country side to Avila, where we will visit the Cathedral containing St. Theresa of Avila's relics, also the crypt of the Convento of la Santa, built on the site of the house where she was born and home of the most comprehensive museum dedicated to her life.

Tuesday, May 15th
Santiago de Compostela (B, D)

Drive through the Asturia Mountains to Santiago de Compostela, located on the north west corner of Spain. Today we will have traveled over the terrain the St. James took in his missionary journeys. Dinner and overnight.

Wednesday, May 16th Santiago de Compostela / Fatima (B, D)

This morning we celebrate Mass at the shrine of St. James followed by sightseeing, then continue to cross the border to Opporto and Coimbra, the famous university town, then head south to Fatima for dinner and overnight.

Thursday, May 17th Fatima (B, D)

Today is a special day with Mass at the Chapel of Apparitions, including the Basilica-site of Francisco's and Jacinta's graves, the Hamlet of Aljustrel where the children lived, the Valhinos-site of Our Lady appearance after the children returned from prison. A new Basilica is under construction, however just as beautiful as the older Basilica that was constructed in 1926. Afternoon visit of Nazare and the Batalha Monastery. Return for dinner and overnight.

Friday, May 18th Santarem / Lisbon (B, D)

Drive to Santarem and visit the Basilica before we continue to Lisbon for sightseeing which will include the Belem Tower guarding the Tagus River, Jeronimo's Monastery with its Tomb. of Vasco de Gama. Dinner and overnight.
