South Africa is a combination of spectacular scenery, diverse wildlife, unique cultures and great infrastructure. We visit the highlights, but also leave the beaten track to explore more.

Accommodation is simple, but comfortable. This tour is not designed for the luxury seeker, but those that seek a good mixture of adventure, activity and value!

### **DAY 1 Depart Canada**

Depart Canada on British Airways from your home city for London Heathrow.

### **DAY 2 Arrive London / Connect to Johannesburg**

Arrival into London Heathrow to make your connection on British Airways for Johannesburg. A free stop in London is available in one direction.

### **DAY 3 Arrive Johannesburg**

On arrival in Johannesburg you will clear customs and await your transfer to the Johannesburg Inn for overnight.

### **DAY 4 Johannesburg – Bushveld Camp**

We depart early travelling through the spectacular Mpumalanga area, visiting several landmarks along the way. We overnight in the tented Bushveld Camp within the Balule Nature Reserve, bordering Kruger National Park. Overnight at Tented Camp. (BD)

### **DAY 5 Bushveld Camp**

Morning walk of approx. 3 hours in search of game, stopping to learn more about the ways of the bush. Afternoon open-vehicle game drive; developing into an extensive night drive. The bush at night provides us with the opportunity of viewing nocturnal animals. This evening we enjoy a hearty bush "braai". Overnight at Tented Camp. (BD)

### **DAY 6 Hazyview**

Today we have a leisurely start, traveling through the rural Bushbuck ridge area to the sleepy settlement of Hazyview. This afternoon we have time to relax at the bird hide, or enjoy swimming or forest walks. Overnight at Inn. (BLD)

### **DAY 7 Kruger National Park**

Leaving Hazyview, we travel the short distance to the world-renowned Kruger National Park. We spend the entire day viewing animals from the high vantage point of our truck. Overnight at Restcamp. (BLD)

### **DAYS 8-9 Swaziland / Zululand**

We travel through the Kingdom of Swaziland, enjoying the spectacular scenery before entering Zululand. Activities include a game walk, game drives and take a Zulu cultural experience. Overnight at Restcamp. (2B 2L 2D)



**DAY 10 Dolphin Coast**

We travel to the Dolphin Coast, one of the world's finest coastlines. Explore the nearby lagoon, enjoy the beach, ocean and a traditional fish "braai". Overnight at Guesthouse. (BLD)

**DAYS 11-12 Drakensberg Mountains**

After a visit to Durban, we travel inland to the majestic Drakensberg mountains. We transfer to a 4x4 vehicle and enjoy an exciting drive to our cozy log cabins. Here we spend time hiking and exploring the wonders of this National Heritage Site. Overnight in Cabins. (2B 1L 2D)

**DAY 13 Ladybrand**

We cross the Oliviershoek Pass to the turquoise waters of Sterkfontein Dam, and on to the Golden Gate National Park, well known for its towering sandstone cliffs and unique wildlife. Those that wish to experience white water rafting have the option here. Overnight on a Guestfarm. (BD)



**DAYS 14-15 Karoo**

We head into the dry Karoo interior, travelling via quaint and remote farming villages to our stone cottages. Opportunity for extensive walks in the mountainous terrain, home to variety of interesting plants, animal and bird life. Overnight at the Guesthouse. (2B 2L 2D)

**DAYS 16-18 Garden Route**

We depart for the pioneer town of Graaff-Reinett where we visit the local museum, before crossing the mighty Outeniqua Mountains to the lush coastal Garden Route area. Our days will be spent exploring this renowned region and its attractions. Among those activities we have on option are forest and coastal walks including a portion of one of the world's most famous hikes, the 'Otter Trail', boat trips to see whales and dolphins or relaxation in great cafes and curio shops. Overnight in Log Cabins. (3B 2L 2D)



**DAYS 19-21 Cape Town**

Leaving Knysna we follow the 'Whale Route', arriving in Cape Town in the afternoon where we check into our Inn on the Sea Point beachfront. We spend the next two days visiting Cape Point, Hout Bay, the waterfront, secluded beaches and a wine farm. We will also hike up Table Mountain. Overnight at Inn. (3B)

**DAY 22 Depart Cape Town**

Today you have the day at leisure until your transfer to the airport for your onward flight on British Airways. (B)

**DAY 23 Connect London / Arrive Canada**

You arrive at London Heathrow where you will make your connection to Canada. A free stop in London is available in one direction.
